Comprehensive Traffic Appraisal for Ardingly Village

Ardingly Parish Council is delighted to announce the appointment of consultants Colin Davis Associates and Hamilton-Baillie Associates to undertake a comprehensive Traffic Appraisal for the parish. Both companies have considerable experience in this type of project and have designed traffic calming schemes that are sensitive to rural character.

Funding has been obtained from West Sussex County

Council's Community Initiative Fund, the National Trust and major local businesses, as well as the parish council.

Chair of the parish council's Traffic Committee Don Walker commented:

"Traffic speed and pedestrian safety has long been identified as the issue of greatest concern locally. I am therefore delighted that we now have such an eminent team to deliver a plan that will identify significant improvements for residents to live in a safe and cohesive community while developing the village's spirit of place."
