

Neighbourhood Planning (Front Runners 5th Wave) GRANT DETERMINATION 2011/12: 31/1986

The Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government ("the Secretary of State") makes the following determination in exercise of the powers conferred by-

- a) Section 72 of the Environment Act 1995, and
- b) Section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003.

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as the Neighbourhood Planning (Front Runners 5th Wave) Grant Determination 2011/12: No. 31/1986.

Purpose of the grant

2. The purpose of the grant is to provide support to authorities in England towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

Determination

3. The Secretary of State determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the amount of grant to be paid, the authorities and amounts in the Annex to this determination.

Consultation

4. Before determining
 - a) the amount of grant payable to National Park authorities in England, and
 - b) the purpose for which that grant is to be made to National Park authorities in England,

the Secretary of State consulted Natural England.

Treasury consent

5. Before making this determination in relation to local authorities in England, the Minister of State obtained the consent of the Treasury.
